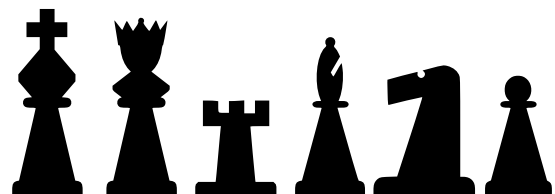

CCE Ranks 6th in Kerala

Christ College of Engineering, Irinjalakuda, has once again demonstrated excellence as it secured a high position in the recently published ranking of engineering colleges based on the academic performance under APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University (KTU). With an impressive 82.05% pass rate, the college ranked 6th in the state and 2nd among private engineering colleges. The ranking is based on the performance of the 2021-2025 batch. Among the students who appeared for the exams, 34.43% secured distinction, while 44.68% achieved first class. Acknowledging the hard work behind this achievement, Executive Director Fr.
