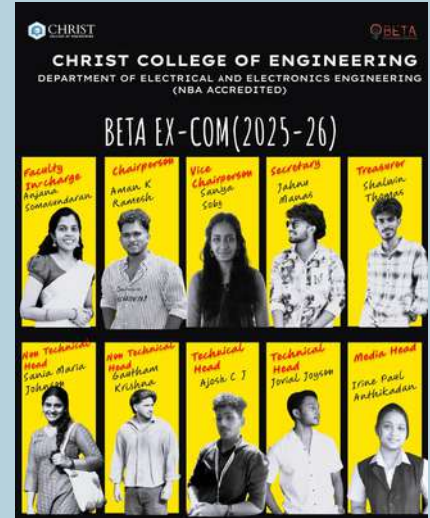

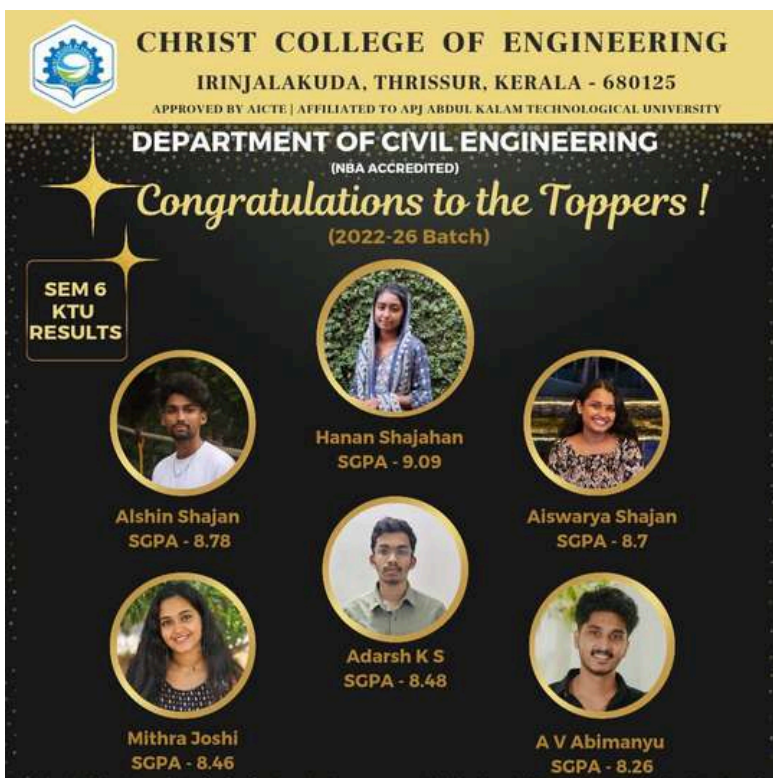

The Freedom Run and Flag Hoisting were grand successes, reflecting unity, social responsibility, and the spirit of independence. 🇮🇳

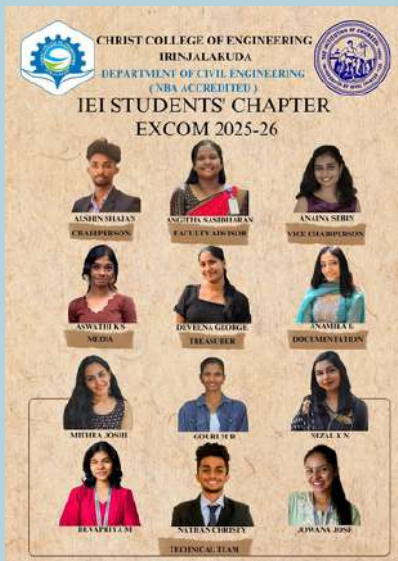

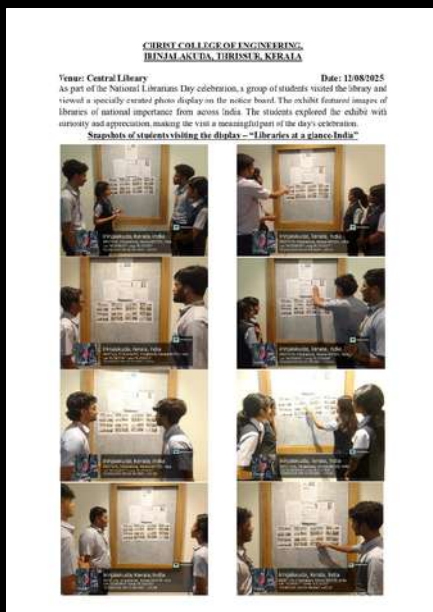
IEI STUDENT'S CHAPTER
