Dr. Antony Balan T.G. (Retd. Chief Engineer, Central Water Commission, New Delhi) inaugurated the 3-day online conference on July 13, 2021 and delivered the inaugural address on the topic 'Water Resource Project Planning and Management'. Eminent academicians Dr. Sanjeeb Mohapatra, Post-Doctoral Research Scholar, Environmental Research Institute, National University of Singapore and Dr. A. V.
